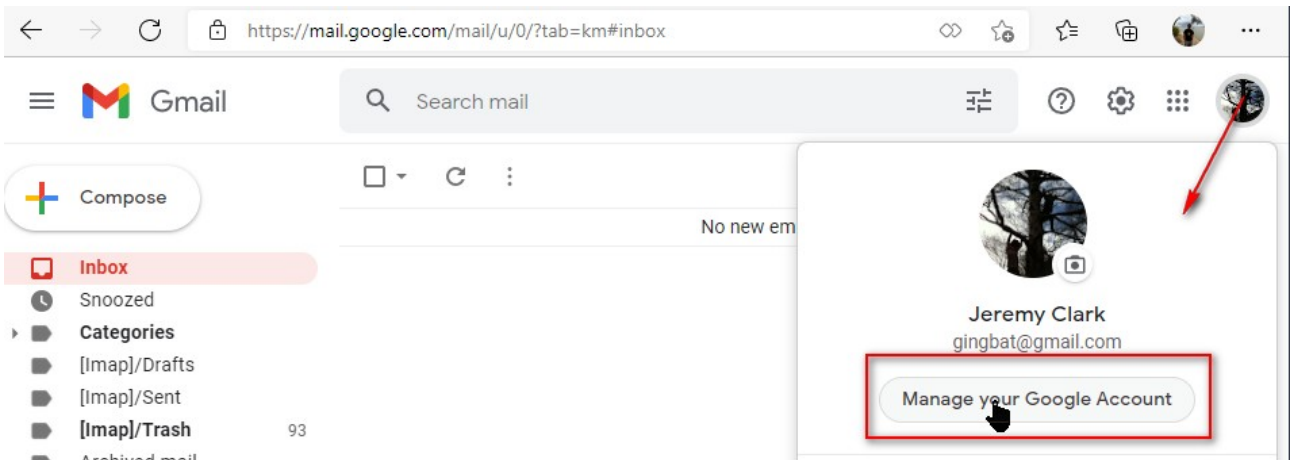
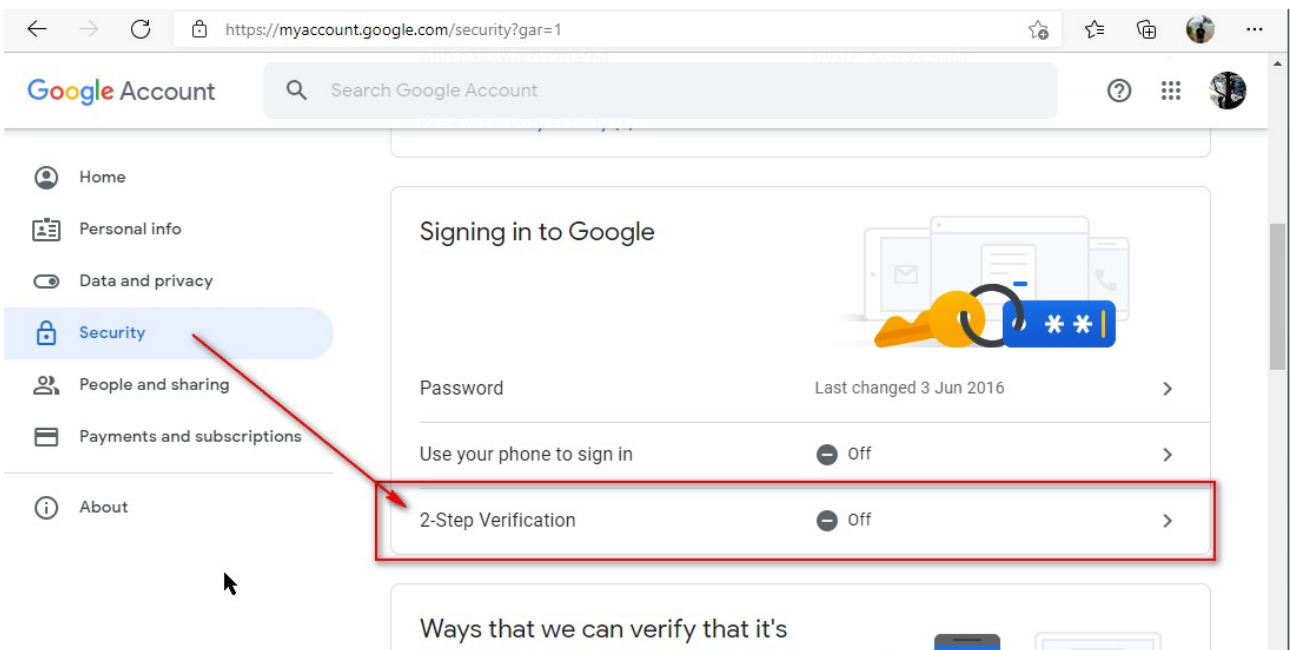


1. Go to your [Google Account](#).
